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I understand and agree to abide by the HANGAR LEASE AGREEMENT available by request from the Airport Administration Department 207-786-0631.

- Hangars shall be for non-commercial aircraft activities and routine maintenance or service of the Tenant's aircraft.
- No non-aviation equipment or property, including motor vehicles, shall be permitted adjacent to the hangars. Tenant's vehicle maybe parked adjacent to the Premises if properly permitted. Tenants shall be held responsible for any costs incurred by the Airport for maintenance resulting in Tenants negligence or abuses of said premises. Tenants shall not assign or sublet their spaces without the consent of the Airport.
- Tenants shall carry at their expense Aircraft Liability insurance including Premises coverage during the term of their lease, with terms and company satisfactory to the Airport, for limits of not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence for Bodily Injury or Property Damage Liability. The Airport, its officers, and employees shall be names as additional insured.
- All aircraft are subject to the State of Maine's Excise Tax. In this manner, the Airport is required to report all aircraft remaining more than 30 days to the City of Auburn, ME to assess the tax as per Title 36; § 1482.1(A); Part II; Chapt. 111: *For the privilege of operating an aircraft within the State, each heavier-than-air aircraft or lighter-than-air aircraft operated in this State that is owned or controlled by a resident of this State is subject to an excise tax computed as follows: 9 mills on each dollar of the maker's average equipped price for the first or current year of model; 7 mills for the 2nd year; 5 mills for the 3rd year; 4 mills for the 4th year; and 3 mills for the 5th and succeeding years. The minimum tax is \$10. Nonresidents of this State who operate aircraft within this State for compensation or hire must pay 1/12 of the tax amount computed as required in this paragraph for each calendar month or fraction thereof that the aircraft remains in the State.*
  - Exemptions will be considered is the Tenant presents proof they pay the Maine State Excise Tax through another State of Maine airport or municipality.
  - Tenant shows proof they pay Excise Tax in a different State.
